The State of California requires annual ET Application Renewal for all Electrician Trainees until you have the required work experience hours (8,000 for General electrician, 4,800 for Residential electrician, or 4,000 for Fire/Life Safety technician, 4000 for Voice Data Video Technician, and 2,000 for Non-residential Lighting Technician) and andpassed the State Electrical Certification Exam.

What is an electrician trainee? Legislation passed in 1999 requiring all electricians who work for a C-10 electrical contractor to be certified by the state of California. Regulations from that legislation were put in place in 2002, setting deadlines for all categories of electricians. Many of those deadlines have already passed.

In California, electrical projects valued at less than \$500 are not regulated. However, electrical projects of \$500 or more require a C-10 electrical contractor license.

The first step to answering how to become an electrician in California is to register with the State. Unlike some states, in California before you begin an apprenticeship or a training program you'll need to register with the State of California Department of Industrial Regulations as an "Electrician Trainee".

Electrician's Apprentices An alternative to electrical certification in California is to sign up for a registered apprentice program. State law exempts apprentices from the certification test, but many apprenticeship programs require that you pass the test to graduate.

To renew your California Electrical license: The California Department of Industrial Relations requires that you complete 32 hours of continuing education for certified electricians. The renewal deadline in California is before the license expiration date, every three years.
